A Word from **Your Mayor**



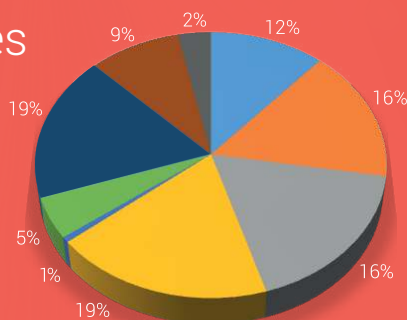
At a special meeting on December 19, 2017, your city council passed the 2018 budget and was pleased to announce that there would be no tax increase in Notre-Dame-de-l'Île-Perrot in 2018. The city council also adopted the 2018/2019/2020 Three-Year Capital Program, which lists planned capital investments over the next three years. Through these investments, the city council is striving to continue to improve municipal infrastructure and services to better meet your expectations and needs.

An important issue in Notre-Dame in 2018 will be the implementation of organic materials collection starting in the fall. It will be a big challenge, but I have full confidence that the residents of NDIP will rise to the occasion. In Notre-Dame-de-l'Île-Perrot, a communications campaign will be launched in the spring to inform residents about the items accepted for organic waste collection.

Although we were able to avoid a change in the tax rate this year, we anticipate impacts on the budget starting in 2019 from expenses over which we have no control (for example the tax portions going to the regional county municipality, Agence régionale de transport métropolitain and Communauté métropolitaine de Montréal). For the past several years, the city council has been able to balance the budget; however, unless new sources of revenue are found, residents will need to be prepared for a potential tax increase.
