MUNICIPAL TAX ACCOUNT 2024

Dear NDIP Residents,

Last December, the City Council approved the budget for the 2024 fiscal year. Given the current economic environment, which is marked by sustained inflation and increases to contributions and contracts, the City requires a 6.5% increase in tax rates to meet its obligations and continue to provide the services that NDIP residents have come to expect.

In addition to the significant increases in annual contributions, the 2024 Budget is affected by the beginning of the fire station's loan by-law repayment. Our rigorous management in Notre-Dame-de-l'Île-Perrot resulted in low debt, which meant that we were not eligible for any subsidies that would reduce the amount of funding required for the fire station. This new infrastructure means we are meeting our objectives, including a marked decrease in response times, but as expected, it has had a significant impact on the City's finances.

To reflect the actual costs of various municipal services, a \$14 rate increase is also required to cover the cost of the new contract for the collection, transportation, and disposal of household waste. This year's increase is reasonable, but it is only the tip of the iceberg. We anticipate an enormous increase in costs over the next five years. The Council therefore invites you to a community discussion on waste management. NDIP ranks among the top cities in terms of organic waste collection, and recyclable material collections are very well established in our territory. However, we are not yet using our black bins effectively. We invite you to complete the Waste Management Habits Survey online (by scanning the attached QR code) or in print form (available in municipal buildings). The results will help us make informed decisions so we can meet financial demands and the expectations of Notre-Dame-de-l'Île-Perrot residents.

For an average home valued at \$465,000, the increase in tax rates and charges for waste collection, transportation and disposal as well as the one-time charge for a new brown bin will result in a \$257 tax increase in 2024. We are proud that Notre-Dame-de-l'Île-Perrot has one of the lowest tax rates in the region while offering great services.

Preparing the 2024 Budget was not easy. I would like to thank the Council for its overall vision in terms of the cost challenges we are facing, and the team for everything they've done throughout the year to stay on top of the city's finances.

PAYING TAXES ONLINE

Municipal taxes may be paid through your financial institution's website in the same way as your other bills. From the list of payees, simply choose one of the following:

In your financial institution's payment interface, enter the 18-digit registration number (numéro de matricule) indicated at the top right of your tax account or the reference number indicated on the payment slip. Taxes can also be paid in person at the Guichet Unique, in Marie-Uguay Library or at City Hall.

Paying your taxes online can save you time, postage and banking fees and you will be contributing to the sound management of the City's finances!
